### **ORDINANCE NO. 2016-17**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MADEIRA BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 34 (ENVIRONMENT), ARTICLE III (NOISE), SECTION 34-89 (EXCEPTIONS) TO CLARIFY THE DEFINITION OF EXCEPTIONS TO THE TERM "LOUD AND RAUCOUS NOISE;" BY PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH TO THE EXTENT OF SUCH CONFLICT; BY PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND BY PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, City Administration is recommending that the Board of Commissioners of the City of Madeira Beach, Florida, amend Section 34-89 to identify and clarify the definition of exceptions to the term "loud and raucous noise;"

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF MADEIRA BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 34 (Environment), Article III (Noise), Section 34-89 (Exceptions) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Madeira Beach, Florida, be hereby revised to hereinafter be and read as follows:

## Sec. 34-89. – Exceptions.

The term "loud and raucous noise" does not include noise or sound generated by the following:

- (1) Cries for emergency assistance and warning calls.
- (2) Radios, sirens, horns and bells on law enforcement, fire and other emergency vehicles.
- (3) Parades, firework displays and other special events for which a permit has been obtained from the city, within such hours as may be imposed as a condition for the issuance of the permit.
- (4) Activities on or in municipal and school athletic facilities and on or in publicly owned property and facilities, provided that such activities have been authorized by the owner of such property or facilities or its agents.
- (5) Fire alarms and burglar alarms, prior to the giving of notice and a reasonable opportunity for the owner or tenant in possession of the premises served by any such alarm to turn off the alarm.
- (6) Bells which are rung or organs which are played to signal religious services.
- (7) Locomotives and other railroad equipment and aircraft.
- <u>SECTION 2.</u> Ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith to the extent that such conflict exists are hereby repealed.
- SECTION 3. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or provision of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not be construed to render the remaining provisions of this Ordinance invalid or unconstitutional.
- <u>SECTION 4.</u> **Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval in the manner approved by law.
