CITY OF MADEIRA BEACH – CONSTRUCTION / TRAFFIC IMPACT
Rex Place Road Reconstruction and Drainage Improvements.

Madeira Beach, FL, January 17, 2017– The City of Madeira Beach has contracted with Keystone Excavators, Inc. to improve Rex Place. Full project completion is set to be within 270 calendar days from December 4, 2017 start date.

This work will require road closures at certain times throughout the project. Upcoming schedule is as follows;

1/18/18 THURS	Zone 2 & Zone 3 will need to be vacated during construction. Zone 2 expected to be open by end of day.
1/19/18 FRI	Zone 3 will need to be vacated during construction. Expected Zone 1, 2, & 3 to be open for parking.
1/22/18 MON	Demo main gate area. Zones 4, 5, 6, 7, & 8 will need to be vacated during construction.
1/23/18 TUES	Set Well Points – Zones 4, 5, 6, 7, & 8. Zones 4 & 5 will need to be vacated during construction. Zones 6, 7, & 8 expected to be open.
1/24/18 WED	Construction to impact main gate. Zones 4 & 5 will need to be vacated during construction.
1/25/18 THURS	Construction to impact main gate. Zones 4 & 5 will need to be vacated during construction.
1/26/18 FRI	Construction to impact main gate. Zone 4 to be backfilled.
1/29/18 MON	Zone 6 will need to be vacated during construction.
1/30/18 TUES	Zone 7 & 8 will need to be vacated during construction. Possibly Zone 6.
1/31/18 WED	Zone 7 & 8 will need to be vacated during construction.
2/1/18 THURS	Zone 8 will need to be vacated during construction. Zone 6 & 7 expected to be open.
2/2/18 FRI	Remove Well Points – Parts of Zone 8 expected to open.

Work will begin weekdays at approximately 7:00 a.m. and will finish around 3:30 p.m. Residents within the active work zone limits who park their cars overnight along Rex Place or within the active construction zone, please be sure to move it prior to the 7:00 a.m. construction start time.

Residents should expect to begin to see utility companies painting the streets and putting little flags in the Right of Way. Please do not remove or alter these marks for the duration of the project.
