*John's Pass Village and Boardwalk*

Madeira Beach, FL, March 1, 2018 – Incident Reported in John's Pass Village and Boardwalk

At approximately at 9:00 p.m. on Wednesday evening at 170 John's Pass Boardwalk an individual was accosted by a thin white man, approximately 4'11" to 5' tall. The suspect was last observed wearing a black hooded sweatshirt and a baseball cap.

The subject communicated that he had a firearm, but to our knowledge no firearm was brandished, the suspect made off with \$400.00 cash. The Pinellas County Sheriff Office established a perimeter, and K-9 Units were deployed to attempt to apprehend the suspect however, due to heavy pedestrian presence and the abundance of other scents the K-9 Units were unsuccessful in apprehending the suspect.
