Madeira Beach City Commission Suspends Parking Fees

MADEIRA BEACH, FL – The Madeira Beach City Commission voted last night to suspend paid parking fees in a City-owned parking lots until further notice. The action was taken in support of local businesses that have been impacted by red tide.

All city parking kiosks have been de-activated and display the message “Free Parking Due to Red Tide”. All parking rules including, no back in parking, no overnight parking and no double space parking remain in effect.

The City maintains parking at the following locations:

- John’s Pass Park, Gulf Blvd. and 129th Avenue West
- John’s Pass Village parking lot, Village Blvd. and 129th Avenue East
- Beach Access lots located on the west side of Gulf Blvd.
- Lots on the west side of Gulf Blvd. at 130th and 132nd Avenue
- Lots on the east side of Gulf Blvd. at 133rd Avenue E and 134th Avenue
- Kitty Stuart Park, Gulf Blvd., and 141st Avenue
- Archibald Memorial Beach Park, 15100 Gulf Blvd.
