City of Madeira Beach Encourages Residents to Vote on November 6th

MADEIRA BEACH, FL – The City of Madeira Beach has sent out a letter from City Manager Jonathan Evans to all residents encouraging them to educate themselves about the 10 Proposed Charter Amendments that will appear on the ballot and to vote on November 6, 2018.

“The proposed changes to the City Charter were developed by the Charter Review Committee which submitted them to the Board of Commissioners for their deliberation. The Board then chose which amendments to place on the ballot for consideration by the voters,” said City Manager Jonathan Evans. “The City is prohibited by law from taking a position on any of the amendments, so we encouraged voters to become informed and vote their conscience on November 6th”.



The City has provided several helpful resources on its website, www.madeirabeachfl.gov, to help inform residents including a copy of the existing Charter, the proposed Amendments, minutes of the Charter Review Committee meetings, a series of FAQ’s, a layman’s translation of the proposed amendment language and links to the [Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections Office](#) as well as the [Florida Division of Elections](#).

The deadline for voter registration for the 2018 General Election is Tuesday, October 9, 2018. Voter registration applications submitted electronically through RegistertoVoteFlorida.gov and voter registration applications sent by mail that are post-marked by October 9 will be accepted.
