City of Madeira Beach Advertises to Fill Board Vacancies

MADEIRA BEACH, FL – The City of Madeira Beach Board of Commissioners vote to set policy, rules, and regulations. Before a vote, the discussion and deliberations of the Board can take anywhere from a few minutes to a few hours. However, the amount of research, fact-finding, and development that goes into an item before it reaches the Board often takes weeks or even months. That work is done by a dedicated group of citizens who volunteer to serve their community by sitting on an Advisory Board.

Currently, the City of Madeira Beach has vacancies on the following Advisory Boards:

- Bid Review Committee
- Budget Review Committee
- Gulf Beaches Library Board
- Planning Commission

While having experience in the area each committee is responsible for is helpful, it is not required. Many elected officials on a local, county, state and federal level began their public service careers by serving on an Advisory Board. The only requirement is that applicants must be a registered voter in the City of Madeira Beach.
